Thank you to all who have given up your time to attend the meetings: **Diocesan Vision for Mission, Planning 2030**. The richness of the discussions on how deeply we feel the gift of faith has been precious. By sharing our own challenges and reflecting on what will help us to nurture and sustain our faith to overcome those challenges was positive. Thank you for completing the questionnaire. Together with our parish representatives, we have met to distil the responses from the questionnaires and captured the reflections from our meetings. We will feed this back to the next Deanery meeting, following which findings from our parish, deanery and the steps the Bishop will be taking will be shared in due course.

'Let us go elsewhere, to the neighbouring country towns, so that I can preach there too because that is why I came.' In the Gospel of Mark there is a theme that is referred to in Theological circles as 'The Messianic Secret'. Throughout the Gospel Jesus has to hide from the crowds and tell people not to tell others what He has done for them. In the two Sundays before Lent begins we have great examples of this great 'secret', while he is in Capernaum. However, Jesus is very clear. His purpose in life was to preach, to make His Father known to everyone He met. While that may have made Him more popular than He liked and was forced to constantly have to find quieter places to be, 'that is why I came.'

So, if we have lost our purpose in life let's turn to our Lord and find our purpose in Him. Then, when we know our purpose in life, even if that makes us more popular than we would like to be we can rest assured that is why we are here.

I give to the Trustees of the Arundel and Brighton Diocesan Trust of Bishop's House The Upper Drive Hove East Sussex BN3 6NB being registered charity Number 252878 [the sum of £..... free of tax] [.....of my residuary estate] on trust for such charitable purposes in connection with St Mary Magdalene's Parish, Bexhill on Sea, in the said Diocese as the Trustees shall in their absolute discretion think fit and the receipt of the Financial Secretary or other officer of the Trust shall be a full discharge to my executors in respect of the same.
