Bishop Richard thanks everyone for their thoughts and opinions on his consultation on the Mission of the church. On 26th February representatives from each of the parishes in our St Leonard's on Sea Deanery presented to the Bishop their parish's response to the questions raised. Bishop Richard was very much impressed and encouraged by our responses. He was very grateful for everyone's time and effort. He still has one more Deanery to visit across the Diocese (we were his 12th Deanery visit out of 13) to gauge their views.

He will come back to us, with a view to presenting more in-depth outcomes of this consultation processing over the coming months. We presented the Bishop with your completed questionnaires and he confirms that they will be placed in the relevant Deanery folder and will be looked at with great care and concern. He has instructed a team to help him look through all the questionnaires from all the Deaneries. He also confirmed that along with Sarah Kilmartin, Financial Secretary, and his team will be travelling around the Diocese again. These will be open meetings in which he will present the Pastoral Plan. The Bishop asks for our prayers and indeed one of the intercessions this Sunday will be for the future mission of the Diocese.

On the 3rd Sunday of Lent Gospel (John 2: 13–25), Jesus refers to his own body as the temple. I can assume that, in Christ's image, my body is also a temple for God. We the Church, the Body of Christ, are collectively a temple for God. What is God telling me about how important it is to keep my "inner room" free to encounter God? God deeply desires that space for encounter from you and me.
