St Peter

Originally named Simon, son of John, has his name changed to Cephas (Peter), or perhaps, more accurately it is a change to a new status. It is a name meaning 'Rock', and upon this rock Christ Jesus founds the Church of God. Coming from Bethsaida in Galilee he was originally a fisherman, now he is to be a 'fisher of men'. Often, he is depicted as rash and hasty and is, perhaps, most famous for his three-fold denial and later his three-fold affirmation of love. Even more so, however, is his recognition of Jesus as the Messiah: *'you are the Christ the Son of the living God'* and *'to whom shall we go? You have the message of eternal life'*. Restored to friendship after the Resurrection he is charged with feeding the sheep, becoming a vicar of Christ, who indicates that he will give his life for the sake of the Gospel. Indeed, the gospels agree that Peter was the leader of the apostles and in any list, he is invariably named first. On Pentecost his preaching is so effective, both because he is a witness to the Resurrection and because of the descent of the Holy Spirit; and following his address three thousand new converts are baptised for Christ. Initially, Bishop of Antioch, the place where followers of Jesus were first called Christian, Peter comes to Rome, to the centre of the [Roman] world, the place where he would give glory to God; the Vatican built over his burial place. He was martyred by Crucifixion, in 64 AD under the persecutions of Emperor Nero following the Great Fire in the city, which Nero himself probably started.

St Paul

Originally named Saul of Tarsus, a Jew who was completely opposed to Christianity, and yet through the grace of God, becomes, perhaps, the most influential person after Jesus himself for the spread of Christianity, his missionary journeys and letters still informing our liturgical celebrations today. We first encounter Saul at the martyrdom of St Stephen. He is a Pharisee and an avid persecutor of the Christians who claimed that Jesus was the Messiah and had been raised from the dead. He was converted to Christianity through a personal encounter with Jesus on the Road to Damascus. Paul attests that he saw the Lord, and this revelation convinced him that Jesus was the Messiah. His skills as a tent maker, no doubt, aided his missionary journeys, meaning he could travel light and set up shop anywhere. His missions established several Churches throughout Asia Minor and Europe, including the Church in Corinth, his letter to the Corinthians we still read today. Arrested for taking a Gentile too far into the Temple precincts in Jerusalem, he was sent to Rome and tradition favours that he died there. He too was martyred in 64 AD under the persecutions of Emperor Nero, but as a Roman Citizen he was spared crucifixion, and was beheaded, the Church of St Pauls outside the Walls built at the place of his martyrdom.
