



The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven

This Thursday is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, body and soul, into Heaven. It is a holy day of obligation and so, Masses are:

**9am at St Martha's in Little Common;
10am at St Mary Magdalene, Town Centre
& 7pm at Our Lady of the Rosary, Sidley**

This doctrine may only have been formally declared in 1950, but it has long been the common belief of the people of God. The Assumption is common sense, following logically from the formal declaration of her Immaculate Conception. It is a matter of justice that the one conceived without original sin and who remained sinless should be spared the corruption of the body that is the effect of sin. If, as we believe, that Christ preserved his mother's virginity before, during and after his birth, it's reasonable that He now preserves her from the corruption of the body. Although, no specific biblical reference, the Assumption is not without scriptural precedence: *the assumption of Elijah and Enoch, and the psalms singing of the heavenly bride being taken to her king.* The Son's love of Mother is rooted in the depths of her body, and all graces are because of her Motherhood. The greeting '*Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with you*' and declaration, '*blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb!*' articulate Our Lady's fulness of grace. This singular holiness and grace mean that Mary, '*the ark of the new and eternal covenant*', is brought home to heaven by the shortest route, and not expected to wait for the Resurrection. The timing of the formal declaration is significant. The World Wars leave a world struggling with Truth and Virtue. Therefore, Pius XII gives us an icon of our true destiny. A person is a unity of body and soul; therefore our redemption won by Christ on the cross is real but not completed until the return of our bodies, the resurrection integral to our salvation: '*o death where is thy sting, o grave where is thy victory?*'
