***In your goodness, O God,
you prepared a home for the poor.***

What you have come to is Mount Zion and the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem where the million of angels have gathered for the festival, with the whole Church in which everyone is a first-born son and a citizen of heaven.

When people say Mass is boring or ask the priest to make it more engaging (entertaining), it can be a sign of a misunderstanding. The Holy Mass is already our source and summit because it is the place where heaven and earth touch and where the whole company of heaven, the angels and saints, have gathered for the festival. Firstly, the Holy Mass is the re-presentation of the Cross, In the Sacred Liturgy we encounter Christ, *'the mediator who brings about a new covenant and a blood for the purification which pleads more insistently than Abel's'*. The Holy Mass celebrates the *'memorial of Christ's saving Passion, his wondrous Resurrection and Ascension into heaven, and as we look forward to his second coming, we offer God in thanksgiving this Holy and living sacrifice'* (EP3). Thus, the priest can only pray the Mass with great reverence and devotion always and only with the mind of the Church because Christ has established the pattern of our worship: *'do this in memory of me'*.

St Paul says *"our citizenship is in heaven, and it is from there that we are expecting a Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ. He will transform the body of our humiliation that it may be conformed to the body of his glory, by the power that also enables him to make all things subject to himself."* (Phil 3:20-21). And so, the Holy Mass is also a foretaste of the heavenly banquet and we are invited to attend the victory banquet of the Lamb of God who has taken away the sins of the world. St Paul affirms the result of our Baptism: *"you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are citizens with the saints and also members of the household of God, built upon the foundations of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the cornerstone. In him the whole structure is joined together and grows into holy temple in the Lord; in whom you also are built together spiritually into a dwelling place for God"*. (Eph 2:19-22).

At the end of our pilgrimage, at the judgement at the end of the world, we want the King to say to us, *'Come, you that are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world'*. (Mt 25:34).
