

Week of Prayer to
Our Lady of the Rosary
29th Sept to 6th Oct

Directed and led by Fr Stephen

At the bishop's suggestion, we will dedicate a **week of prayer** to prepare for the closure of the Church in Sidley and the re-dedication of our Parish under the title of "Our Lady of the Rosary". The Week of Prayer commences this Sunday (29th September) at:

- **Sunday 29th September – 9.15am at Our Lady of the Rosary**
- **Monday 30th September to Saturday 5th October inclusive – 9.15am at St Mary Magdalene Church**

All parishioners are welcome to the prayer sessions throughout the week.

For those who cannot attend in the mornings, there is a special "**Evening Prayer of the Church**" in St Mary Magdalene at 7.30pm on **Thursday 3rd October**, during which Fr Simon will give a reflection on the *Blessed Martyrs of Sussex*. In addition, you might like to consider pausing from your work at 12noon and 6pm and pray the "Angelus" as part of this week of prayer:

- *The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary... and she conceived of the Holy Spirit. Hail Mary...*
- *Behold the handmaid of the Lord... let it be done unto me according to thy word. Hail Mary...*
- *And the Word was made flesh... and dwelt among us. Hail Mary...*
- *Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God... that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.*
- *Let us pray: pour forth, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy grace into our hearts, that we to whom the incarnation of Christ Thy Son, was made known by the message of an angel, may by His Passion + and Cross be brought to the glory of His Resurrection, through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.*

However, you choose to support this prayer initiative, please do make it a priority throughout the week so that we may all prepare for the next stage in the mission to which the Lord has called us.

Being an Angel

If September 29th were not a Sunday we would be celebrating Michaelmas, i.e. Mass in honour of St Michael the Archangel and his fellow Archangels, Gabriel and Raphael. On Wednesday 2nd October we'll be honouring the Holy Guardian Angels, so let's brush up our angelology.

The word 'angel' comes from a Greek word meaning 'messenger', and there are several message-bearing angels in Scripture, the most high-profile of all being the Archangel Gabriel who was sent by God to Mary, asking her to be the mother of Jesus. But in Scripture angels are also companions, alongsiders; the book of Tobit is about a journey made by Tobias, Tobit's son, to a distant city in the company of a mysterious travelling companion who is finally revealed as the Archangel Raphael; it is Raphael who ensures Tobias's safe journey and happy marriage, and who heals Tobias's father's blindness. No angel, no success. In the New Testament Jesus is strengthened for his hideous passion by the appearance of an angel in Gethsemane. The angel is not reported as speaking any words but his presence is vital.

So angels do three things: they bring messages, they walk alongside, they give strength. Have you ever encountered an angel? Not the heavenly variety, perhaps, but, please God, someone in your life who did what angels do; who spoke a good word, whether of encouragement, warning or good counsel; who walked beside you, making a vital difference by his or her alongsideness; someone whose presence gave you strength in your time of desolation.

Thanks be to God for the angels with a small 'a' in our lives, without whom you and I could so easily have come to grief; they were sent by God whether they themselves know it or not. And, as we give thanks for these 'men and women who have touched our lives so powerfully, let us be ready to do the same for others. 'Be an angel', we sometimes say to each other, asking for some small favour; a happy expression, but let us give it its best and loveliest meaning.
