“Year of the Word: The God who Speaks” Formation & Training for Readers

Saturday 18th January 2020

Readers are invited to come to the 10am Mass this Saturday. After Mass, there will be *Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, during which there will be a reflection on Dei Verbum & Verbum Domini*, followed by practical input on of proclaiming the Word of God (Ends 12noon). All parishioners welcome. We will have a **special commissioning of readers for 2020 on 3rd Sunday in OT (25/26th Jan), the Sunday of the Word of God.**

The Lord will bless his people with peace.

‘And a voice spoke from heaven.

This is my Son, the Beloved; my favour rests on him.’

The **Catechism** says, *‘Holy Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian Life, the gateway to the life in the Spirit, and the door which gives access to the other sacraments. Through Baptism we are freed from sin and reborn as sons of God; we become members of Christ, are incorporated into the Church and made sharers in her mission.’* (CCC 1213). **St Paul** says, *‘you have been taught that when we were baptised in Christ Jesus we were baptised in his death; in other words, when we were baptised we went into the tomb with him and joined him in death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead by the Father’s glory, we too might live a new life. If in union with Christ we have imitated his death, we shall also imitate him in his resurrection.’* (Rom 6:3-5). **St Peter** says, *‘you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a consecrated nation, a people set apart to sing the praises of God who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. Once you were not a people at all and now you are the People of God; once you were outside the mercy and now you have been given mercy’.* (1 Peter 9-10). **Our Lord** instructs the disciples, *‘Go, therefore, make disciples of all the nations; baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teach them to observe all the commands I gave you. And know that I am with you always; yes, to the end of time.’* (Mt 28:18-20). Therefore, there should be an urgency in requesting baptism and a desire to complete the preparation and formation so that the sacrament may be received with understanding by the individual or parents in the case of a child. In 2020, the clergy look forward to saying, *‘N, I baptise you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit’*. With every blessing, Fr Simon.
