Who is the king of glory? It is the Lord.

At Last, all-powerful Master, you give leave to your servant to go in peace, according to your promise.

For my eyes have seen your salvation which you have prepared for all nations, the light to enlighten the Gentiles and give glory to Israel, your people.

(Lk 2:29-32)

Forty days have passed since the celebration of the Lord's Nativity and now we turn a corner and look towards the celebration of Easter. Christ the Saviour has come to bring salvation by revealing to us the worship of and the participation in the life of the Most Holy Trinity. Today's Feast celebrates his presentation in the Temple: '*The Lord is now about to enter his temple, he who is and who was and who is to come, God among us, comes to make his dwelling*'. He comes to his Father's house so we may see that this child is '*the light of the world*', not just the light of Israel. We too present ourselves in the Church as we also long to reach the Father's house.

Today's Feast is also a Feast of Our Lady, the feast of her purification. Being Immaculately Conceived and perfect in her Virginity, before, during and after birth, she has no need of a purification but she respects the law of Moses and comes to make the prescribed ritual offering. In reality, this is a further moment of epiphany, as what she is really offering is Christ himself, the Lamb of God, the culmination of all the sacrifices that have been offered. In this Holy Mass, and in all Masses, the priest, on behalf of the people, offers Jesus to the Father.

The candles we bless today are perfect sacrifices. They give themselves totally, burning themselves out for the praise of God, continuing our prayers long after we have left the Church.
