**From the desk of the Parish Priest (updated)**

***"The Obligation to hear Mass on Sundays remains suspended until further notice".***

"You've got to start somewhere". From Sunday evening, we celebrate our first public Mass since they were suspended on 20<sup>th</sup> March. **Note:** The resumption of public Masses is very limited, and **we should not view it as a return to normal**. The liturgical space in St Mary Magdalene has been reworked to enable Baptisms, and benches shifted to ensure social distancing, reducing the capacity of the Church to **55 people**. As families and couples may sit together, an extra couple of people might be accommodated at the stewards discretion. With the furlough of the parish administrators there is no booking system. It is '*first come*' – '*first served*'. A more detailed update is available in the newsletter section of our parish website:

As the **obligation to hear Mass on Sundays remains suspended** any Mass across the week may be attended and, in charity, please only attend one Mass each week. ***If you are in anyway nervous about social distancing, you should not feel compelled to come to Mass.*** Indeed, with a capacity of only 55 people, most parishioners will still need to make use of the Live Stream Masses which have fed us spiritually throughout lockdown. ***Once the Church has reached its capacity***, the stewards will invite you to either come back on another day or invite you to come back later when the Church is open for private prayer.

We have also booked in some Adult and Children's Baptisms and Receptions into Full Communion. Under the guidelines, these '*cycle of life*' celebrations, as the Government calls them, are limited to 30 people at any one time, *which is a clarification on previous announcements made*. As this is only a gradual and limited opening up of public Masses, there will still be a wait until we can celebrate First Holy Communions and Confirmations.

Finally, to have more Masses, we need more volunteer **stewards!**

### **New**

**Requiem Mass of Josephine (Siobhan) Dolan RIP:** The Requiem Mass of Josephine Dolan, known to many by her Traditional Irish name of Siobhan, will be held in St Mary Magdalene Church at 10.30am on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> July. Government Guidance restricts attendance at funerals 30 people. Therefore, **this Mass is for family and nominated friends only and the list of names is already at capacity.**

**Volunteer Stewards:** It would be good to add another two teams at St Mary Magdalene before moving on to think about provision at St Martha's. Fr Simon has sought a slight clarification over the DBS requirement. It seems that we may have been overly cautious. Not every volunteer must have a DBS check with the parish, just as long as there is at least one volunteer in the team and on duty who hold a Parish DBS then the others may assist providing that they are not over 70 or have any COVID-19 underlying health conditions.

**Mass Intentions for August:** There are some Mass intention slots available for the month of August. **Baptisms:** We have permission to celebrate Baptisms again, and there is a backlog to clear. We have contacted most families and continue to work through the list. You do not need to contact us. In order not to add to the backlog, July baptisms may continue as scheduled. We must adhere to the routines of '*supervision, cleaning and social distancing*' and we will explain that to families when we contact them. We will then direct you to the online preparation.

**First Holy Communion:** The First Holy Communion Masses for 2020 continue to be delayed, and regrettably we are not yet able to announce a new date.

**Confirmation:** The Confirmation Mass for 2020 continues to be delayed. As this also affects the Deanery the conversation with the Dean is on-going.

**What about applications for the 2021 programmes?** We are not yet accepting applications as we do not yet know how these courses will be run.

For urgent requests do not ring the parish office as our administrators are now unavailable:

**For people at home:** email [stmm@btconnect.com](mailto:stmm@btconnect.com) or [simon.dray@abdiocese.org.uk](mailto:simon.dray@abdiocese.org.uk) and we will check what is the most appropriate option or speak directly with Fr Simon (opt 3) or Fr Rajesh (opt 2) on 01424 210 263; you may need to leave a voicemail.

**For people in Care, Residential & Nursing Homes:** Please first check with the care home to see if visits are possible / advisable and then ask the care home to ring the priests direct: Fr Simon opt 3 or Fr Rajesh opt 2 on 01424 210 263 – they may need to leave a voicemail message. We will discuss with them what is most appropriate.

**For those in Eastbourne DGH or Conquest Hospital:** You must ring the Conquest Hospital Chaplaincy on 01424 757088 who are co-ordinating emergency response for both hospitals (or ask the Ward to contact the on-call Catholic Chaplain).

**For Bexhill Hospital:** ask the ward to phone Fr Rajesh on 01424 210 263 (opt 2) and he will discuss with them what is appropriate.

It may be that visits are not appropriate, especially if the person is self-isolating to protect themselves. The most appropriate support might be via the telephone.
