St Mary Magdalene Church will be open for private prayer on:

- 11am -12noon Saturdays
- 11am - 12noon on Sundays
- 11am – 12 noon on Tuesdays
- 7pm – 8pm on Thursdays
- 11am – 12noon on Fridays

(except when Requiem Masses are being celebrated, which take precedence). The Church will be closed on Monday and Wednesdays. St Martha's will be closed until Sat 5th December. **Baptisms** scheduled for this time are postponed.

As St Martha's will have been closed for a month, we invite people to help clean the Church ahead a hoped resumption of Mass. You need to be under 70 to help and free from any COVID underlying health conditions. Please let the office know if you can help.

After watching the Presidential election in the USA, we may be grateful for our constitutional monarchy! As Catholics, we have a high view of monarchy providing it is modelled on Our Lord Jesus Christ '*who came not to be served but to serve and give his life as a ransom for many*'. We have a low view of certain historical monarchs who asserted their privilege for their own political advantage, power and wealth. Holy Baptism granted us all a share in Christ's Kingship as we were anointed *priests, prophets and kings*. As a royal household, the Church announces our King's decree – his gospel - so that his subjects may be filled with *faith, hope and love* and take their place in His Kingdom, which is '*an eternal and universal kingdom, a kingdom of truth and life, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love and peace*'. As this liturgical year draws to a close, we prepare for the Advent of Our Lord Jesus Christ, his second coming when those who have been faithful take their place in the kingdom which will be manifested in its fullness. To borrow a line from Tolkien, we are awaiting the '*Return of the King*', and so Advent is a season of preparation and hope. Yes, we will be on the count down to Christmas and we hope soon to have an answer on how we may celebrate it, in the world and in the Church. This will need the continued good work of our parish stewards.

First Holy Communion Masses: all 4 Masses are now postponed. New dates will be announced after the lockdown period ends.

Supplementary Forms for St Mary Magdalene Primary School: Parents are required to sign the declaration that they have, "YES or "NO" attended Sunday Mass at least once a month for at least one year prior to the closing date for applications" (16 January 2020 to 15 January 2021). This has not been possible from April 2020 due to Covid-19, because the church was closed between 20th March and 4th July. Although public worship has resumed, due to the government limitations on public gatherings and the need for some to continue shielding, the Sunday obligation to attend Mass remains suspended. Fr Simon is still required to countersign the Mass attendance declaration, and you are now declaring that you have "YES" or "NO" attended Mass at least one month prior to April 2020.

NEW SIGNING DATES: Due to the lockdown the 9am session on Sat 28th November is **cancelled**.

Fr Simon will sign forms at St Mary Magdalene Presbytery at **9am on Saturday 5th December and at 9am on Saturday 12th December**. It will be on a first come-first served basis and there will be a socially distanced queue. You should begin to look for your baptism certificates now, as there is a charge of £10 to replace them via stmm@btconnect.com in advance of the signing dates.
