

Local Suspension of Public Mass from 2nd January to 5th January inclusive:

I have taken a local decision to suspend all public Masses in the Parish of Our Lady of the Rosary, Bexhill-on-Sea, until the Feast of the Epiphany on 6th January 2021.

The heating is not working at St Martha's Church, St Mary Magdalene Church, St Mary Magdalene Presbytery or in St Mary Magdalene Hall. The temperature in the Churches this weekend is below what is tolerably acceptable. We also have at least one steward who is in a precautionary self-isolation, meaning the 11am Mass is 'under-staffed'.

Therefore, there will be no Public Masses for 2nd Sunday of Christmas (3rd January 2021) in either of our Churches, but I will Live Stream Mass on Facebook (www.facebook.com/stmmbexhill) and then upload it to You Tube afterwards. The Live Stream Masses will be at:

- 6pm Saturday, 11am & 6pm.

Fr Rajesh will carry the 10am Saturday and 9am Sunday Mass Intentions privately in the presbytery.

**Please remember that the obligation to hear Mass on Sunday
is currently suspended.**

In addition, there were no Public Masses scheduled for the Vigil of Sunday, Monday 4th January or Tuesday 5th January, these were already listed as Facebook Masses due to the unavailability of stewards for January.
