

## Novena to St Joseph: (Feast Day 19<sup>th</sup> March)

*Ranking as a Solemnity, even though it be a Friday, the obligation of abstinence from meat is suspended on 19<sup>th</sup> March. Being a special year of St Joseph, it is entirely appropriate to celebrate and feast on 19<sup>th</sup> March*

10<sup>th</sup> March: Novena to St Joseph (Day 1)

**1** The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham.<sup>[a]</sup>

<sup>12</sup> And after the deportation to Babylon: Jechoni'ah was the father of She-al'ti-el,<sup>[b]</sup> and She-al'ti-el<sup>[c]</sup> the father of Zerub'babel,<sup>13</sup> and Zerub'babel the father of Abi'ud, and Abi'ud the father of Eli'akim, and Eli'akim the father of Azor,<sup>14</sup> and Azor the father of Zadok, and Zadok the father of Achim, and Achim the father of Eli'ud,<sup>15</sup> and Eli'ud the father of Elea'zar, and Elea'zar the father of Matthan, and Matthan the father of Jacob,<sup>16</sup> and Jacob the father of Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom Jesus was born, who is called Christ.<sup>[d]</sup>

<sup>17</sup> So all the generations from Abraham to David were fourteen generations, and from David to the deportation to Babylon fourteen generations, and from the deportation to Babylon to the Christ fourteen generations. (Mt 1, 12-17)

<sup>18</sup> Now the birth of Jesus Christ<sup>¶</sup> took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child of the Holy Spirit; <sup>19</sup> and her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to send her away quietly. <sup>20</sup> But as he considered this, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, “Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit; <sup>21</sup> she will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.” <sup>22</sup> All this took place to fulfil what the Lord had spoken by the prophet:

<sup>23</sup> “Behold, a virgin shall conceive and bear a son,

and his name shall be called Emman’u-el”

(which means, God with us).

(Luke 2: 1-7).

<sup>39</sup> And when they had performed everything according to the law of the Lord, they returned into Galilee, to their own city, Nazareth. <sup>40</sup> And the child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favor of God was upon him. (Lk 2:22-24, 39-40)

This was to fulfil what the Lord had spoken by the prophet, "Out of Egypt have I called my son."

<sup>19</sup> But when Herod died, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt, saying, <sup>20</sup> "Rise, take the child and his mother, and go to the land of Israel, for those who sought the child's life are dead." <sup>21</sup> And he rose and took the child and his mother, and went to the land of Israel. <sup>22</sup> But when he heard that Archela'us reigned over Judea in place of his father Herod, he was afraid to go there, and being warned in a dream he withdrew to the district of Galilee. <sup>23</sup> And he went and dwelt in a city called Nazareth, that what was spoken by the prophets might be fulfilled, "He shall be called a Nazarene." (Mt 2:13-15, 19-23)

<sup>39</sup> And when they had performed everything according to the law of the Lord, they returned into Galilee, to their own city, Nazareth. <sup>40</sup> And the child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favor of God was upon him. <sup>41</sup> Now his parents went to Jerusalem every year at the feast of the Passover. <sup>42</sup> And when he was twelve years old, they went up according to custom; <sup>43</sup> and when the feast was ended, as they were returning, the boy Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem. His parents did not know it, <sup>44</sup> but supposing him to be in the company they went a day's journey, and they sought him among their kinsfolk and acquaintances; <sup>45</sup> and when they did not find him, they returned to Jerusalem, seeking him. <sup>46</sup> After three days they found him in the temple, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions; <sup>47</sup> and all who heard him were amazed at his understanding and his answers. <sup>48</sup> And when they saw him they were astonished; and his mother said to him, "Son, why have you treated us so? Behold, your father and I have been looking for you anxiously." <sup>49</sup> And he said to them, "How is it that you sought me? Did you not know that I must be in my Father's house?"<sup>[e]</sup> <sup>50</sup> And they did not understand the saying which he spoke to them. <sup>51</sup> And he went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was obedient to them; and his mother kept all these things in her heart. <sup>52</sup> And Jesus increased in wisdom and in stature,<sup>[f]</sup> and in favor with God and man. (Lk 2: 39-52)
