

## **All Saints**

Our Celebration of All Saints this year actually takes place on Halloween (*which is properly All Hallows Eve*), a day when the Church reminds itself of the reality of Death but always in the context of All Saints (our true destiny) and the month of November in which we keep a vigil of prayer for the faithful departed that they may complete their purification in purgatory and, God willing, take their place in the Communion of Saints. This is the month when we contemplate the Four Last Things: Death, Judgement, Purgatory, Heaven or Hell. All of us will be called to give an account of our lives but today, *‘let us all rejoice in the Lord, as we celebrate the feast day in honour of all the Saints, at whose festival the Angels rejoice and praise the Son of God’*.
