

Sunday of the Word of God.

In 2019, Pope Francis designated the Third Sunday of Ordinary Time as '*The Sunday of the Word of God*', so that we may know that the Lord's words are '*spirit and they are life*'. In the Mass, we find that '*the Word of the Lord*' permeates the Liturgy, not just in the readings but also in the various antiphons and psalms, hence why they have a high priority for singing, ranking above devotional hymns in our planning. In the Liturgy of the Word, the Church encourages us not to have our heads buried in a personal missal but to sit up and listen to the 'Word' being **proclaimed**. This prepares us for service, the fulfillment of our baptismal dignity to '*go and announce the Gospel of the Lord*', so people appreciate that the scriptures continue to be '*fulfilled today, even as we listen*'. At the height of social distancing, both Fr Rajesh and I were minimizing our close contacts, restricting access to the sacristy and sanctuary, meaning we employed the exception of the General Instruction of the Roman Missal: '*the readings are to be read by a reader, but the Gospel by the Deacon or Priest*' but if no '*suitable reader is present, the Priest celebrant should... proclaim the other readings as well*' (*GIRM 59*). Overtime, we have seen a gradual return to parishioners proclaiming the readings, but occasionally the exception is needed. If you are a parish reader, when you arrive at Mass, do please make yourself known to a welcomer or the celebrant to see if you are needed, as it is not always immediately obvious who is available until the last minute. Ideally, those called upon to read will have prayed with the readings during the week, using material such as the "*Wednesday Word*" so that they may read with clarity and understanding, to aid in the **listening** mentioned above. If you can take on the role of a Reader's Coordinator for a Parish Mass, please contact the parish office. God bless. Fr Simon.

The Sacraments

Adult Baptism (Aged 18+): new applications can be submitted from September 2022 for Baptism at Easter 2023. Prospective applicants can book an initial appointment to see Fr Simon from Easter 2022.

Infant Baptism (Aged 0-6): applications submitted via the website: <https://stmbexhill.co.uk/baptism/>

Children of Catechetical (Aged 7-12): Children aged 7+ have reached the age of reason and need to be prepared individually. These applications are assessed on a case-by-case basis and an initial interview with Fr Simon may be necessary before accepting your application. Applications can be submitted via the website: <https://stmbexhill.co.uk/we-journey-together/> (*Please also use this form for children baptized in the Anglican Communion now seeking to be received into full communion with the Catholic Church.*)

Young Adults (Aged 13-17): Please book an appointment to see Fr Simon to discuss your needs. It is likely that we will prepare you using the Confirmation Course which begins in the autumn of 2022.

First Holy Communion: Applications are now **closed** for First Communion 2022. Children should now be working on the 1st Chapter of I Belong ahead of their 1st Confession during the first half of Lent.

Marriage: those getting married in 2023 should see Fr Simon soon, as 12 months' notice is required.
