27th Jan 2022: COVID Precautions

Although Face coverings are no longer legally required, case rates, especially in our schools, remain significant. The bishops therefore recommend their continued use for now. The Church is ventilated, so please wear warm clothing.



Although our liturgies continue to have brevity in mind, we will see a gradual return of suspended items, such as holy water, hymn books, sign of peace, and bidding prayers, but let us remain kind and patient with one another and not expect everything in one go. Although sanitizing is not strictly needed, it remains a courtesy to others to leave our place clean and ready for the next person, so please continue to wipe down your place.

13th February: St Valentine (14th Feb. 2022).

In the reformed liturgical calendar, St Valentine has been bumped by the Feast of St Cyril and Methodius. Dare I say it, this is an own goal. As people go '*loopy in love*' on St Valentine's Day, what they need to hear from the Church is a robust sermon on love; an '*agape*' love which is sacrificial. As the Communion antiphon sings, '*God so loved the world that he gave his Only Son, so that all who believe in him may not perish, but may have eternal life*'. Real love is Eucharist, '*this is my body which is given up for you*', hence why Christian Marriage must be brought before the Altar on the wedding day and throughout married life. As ascribed to St Francis of Assisi, it is '*in giving that we receive*', so '*agape*' love seeks the good of the other, a subject of freedom and never an object of our desire. May God bless you in love. Fr Simon.

20th February 2022: Preparing for 1st Reconciliation

By 20th February, the children enrolled on the 2022 First Holy Communion Course should now be beginning ***Chapter 4 of the I Belong Course book*** ahead of their 1st Reconciliation (Confession) in St Mary Magdalene. Fr Simon and Fr Rajesh will both be available to hear Parish & First Confessions at ***10.30am on Saturday 5th, 12th, 19th, and 26th March***. Your child will be asked to bring their course book to show the priests their progress, and they should be able to say the ***Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be, and an act of Contrition*** (*these are all in the course book*). Parents and carers are also encouraged to make a Confession, not only setting a good example to their child, but also as a normal part of their spiritual preparation for Easter. If you have not yet done so, First Holy Communion families should be making their return to ***in-person worship at Mass***. God Bless. Fr Simon.

The Sacraments

Adult Baptism (Aged 18+): new applications can be submitted from September 2022 for Baptism at Easter 2023. Prospective applicants can book an initial appointment to see Fr Simon from Easter 2022.

Infant Baptism (Aged 0-6): applications submitted via the website: <https://stmbexhill.co.uk/baptism/>

Children of Catechetical (Aged 7-12): Children aged 7+ have reached the age of reason and need to be prepared individually. These applications are assessed on a case-by-case basis and an initial interview with Fr Simon may be necessary before accepting your application. Applications can be submitted via the website: <https://stmbexhill.co.uk/we-journey-together/> (*Please also use this form for children baptised in the Anglican Communion now seeking to be received into full communion with the Catholic Church.*)

Young Adults (Aged 13-17): Please book an appointment to see Fr Simon to discuss your needs. It is likely that we will prepare you using the Confirmation Course which begins in the autumn of 2022.

First Holy Communion: Applications are now **closed** for 2022. Throughout February the children should be aiming to complete **Chapters 3 & 4 of 'I Belong'**, ahead of 1st Confessions during the first half of Lent.

Marriage: those getting married in 2023 should see Fr Simon soon, as 12 months' notice is required.
