For you my soul is thirsting, O Lord, my God.

'Prima Testis'

(*'The First Witness'*)

St Mary Magdalene is the first witness to the Resurrection and the first to share in the mission of announcing the gospel. The Church calls her the '*apostle to the Apostles*' after firstly being granted a great mercy in being alleviated from her grief, up to this point believing that Jesus is dead and buried. She has served Christ well throughout his pastoral ministry, bravely standing with him at the foot of the cross, taking special note of where the body lies. Even now, '*while it is still dark*', she comes to the tomb to complete the burial rites now that the Sabbath day has ended. And yet, like the other disciples of the Lord she has not understood that the cross, far from being the end, is the means of our salvation.

Now we see the significance of the empty tomb, which is not a reason for weeping but an invitation to look beyond the natural, with eyes of faith. Here remains a question: '*who are you looking for?*' For us, the answer is found in the Mass, as we come to find Jesus Christ, present in the gathered assembly, in the priest, in the Word proclaimed, and in the Most Holy Sacrament of the Altar. Like Mary Magdalene, in the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation he has called us by our name. These encounters draw us close to the risen Christ, and as the psalmist sings: '*for you, O Lord my God, my soul is thirsting*'. Again, like Mary, this encounter is not to be held onto, but shared as a great mercy with the community beyond these hallowed walls. Happy Feast Day! Fr Simon.
