Advent

The Sundays of Advent have distinctive themes: The Second Coming (1st), John the Baptist (2nd & 3rd), and the preparation for the Nativity (4th). The first readings are prophecies about the Messiah, with Isaiah a key feature, and in the Epistles, the Apostles speak of day light (1st), hope (2nd) patience (3rd) and mission (4th). Yes, we are preparing for Christmas, but we are reminded of the double sense of Advent, not just the Nativity but the Second Coming when Christ comes again in glory, to judge the living and the dead. And there is also a Third Advent, the celebration of the Eucharist, as Our Lord comes to us '*in word and sacrament, to strengthen us and make us holy*'. The psalmist sings, '*I rejoiced when I heard them say, "let us go to God's house"*', making 1st Sunday of Advent an appropriate time to welcome the Adults on the RCIA course into the catechumenate. **On 1st Sunday of Advent**, the gospel announces the sudden coming of Christ, at an unknown hour, urging us to be vigilant and alert and not be caught unawares. The celebration of the Eucharist is essential preparation for the celebration of the Lord's Nativity, as it enables us to keep 'Christ' and the 'Mass' in 'Christmas'. **On 2nd Sunday of Advent**, St John the Baptist appears, a '*voice crying in the wilderness*' to a society distant from God, exhorting us to '*prepare a way for the Lord*', to '*make his paths straight*'. The Church continues to herald the coming of the Lord in our midst, which is a repentance, making Confession an important preparation for Christmas.
