This Sunday at 2.30pm in St Martha's Church we celebrate our Christingle Advent Service, followed by refreshments in the hall. This is a celebration of our baptismal dignity of being '*priests, prophets, and kings*', helping us "**Let your Light Shine**" in service of the gospel. It is our **mission** '*to celebrate, share, and hand on the Catholic and Apostolic Faith, through our pronouncement of the gospel of Jesus Christ, in both word and deed, all for the greater glory of God and the salvation of souls*'. As Jesus said to John's disciples, '*go and tell people what you see and hear*', a **vision** of '*a community filled with God's grace and the power of the Holy Spirit*'. Please God, people will see '*a caring community where people express the love of Christ in the corporal and spiritual works of mercy*' and people who are prepared '*to know the Lord Jesus more clearly, to love him more dearly, and follow him more nearly, day by day*'. Over the past three weeks we have focused on Christ's Second Coming, but from 17th December, we can intensify our preparation to celebrate Christmas together with '*solemn worship and glad rejoicing*'.
