How happy are the poor in spirit; theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

In Matthew's Gospel this Sunday we listen to Our Lord's teaching on what is essential to our behaviour as Christians. The Catechism of the Catholic Church summarises the importance of the Beatitudes as being 'at the heart of Our Lord's teaching' and they confront us with 'decisive moral choices' and teach us that 'true happiness is not found in riches or well-being, in human fame or power, or in any human achievement.....but in God alone' (CCC 1716-1724).

In contrast:

Satan's Beatitudes might read:

Blessed are those who are too tired, too busy, too distracted to spend an hour once a week with their fellow Christians in Church – they are my best workers.

Blessed are those who wait to be asked and expect to be thanked – I can use them in my business.

Blessed are those who are touchy. Soon they will stop going to Church – verily, they shall be my missionaries.

Blessed are those who sow gossip and trouble – they are my beloved children.

Blessed are those who have no time to pray – for they are MY prey.

Blessed are those who gossip – for they are my secret agents. Blessed are you when you read this and think it has everything to do with other people, and nothing to do with you – I've got room for YOU at my inn.

There is a saying along the lines of 'we will never truly become happy and find ourselves until we break the mirror'. In other words, we have to stop looking at ourselves and look outside to others that we might help. In praying for other people rather than ourselves we learn to grow our relationship with God. In helping others, we help ourselves to become more thoughtful and less selfish and we feel better for it. We might take notice of the words of a Christian poster 'Be Patient – God hasn't finished with me yet!' and let God work with us and in us to become and do what he wants us to be and do.
