Heating Update

Weekend of 25th / 26th February 2023

The heating manufacturer reports a global shortage of raw materials to make new parts. Although the weather has been milder, the Church has retained the cold, and is still too cold. Thus, our Vigil Mass is at St Martha's and the 11am Mass at St Mary Magdalene will not be celebrated.

St Martha's Car Park

The car park at St Martha's is for those attending services or events in the Church and / or Hall. Those wishing to use the public amenities in the village are directed to the public car park. The gates to the car park will be locked and secured after services and / or events. Parking outside of these times risks the vehicle being locked in. **Please do not 'double park' down the middle of the car park, and respect any area coned off.** We must allow access for emergency vehicles & ensure safe passage of parishioners who are on foot moving around the site.

Have mercy on us, O Lord, for we have sinned.

The age-old question, do Sundays count in Lent?

Our Lord enters the desert for *'forty days and forty nights'*, and with Sundays it would be forty-six days. Every Sunday is a celebration of the Resurrection, so are always Feast Days. And yet, notice the changes: the purple reflecting a penitential character, and we *'fast'* from the Gloria and the "A" word and in keeping with this *'desert'* experience we make more space for the Lord by recognizing the need for silence in our lives.

St John Paul II said, *"we need silence if we are to accept in our hearts the full resonance of the voice of the Holy Spirit and to unite our personal prayer more closely to the Word of God and the public voice of the Church"*. Our Bishops said *'silence helps us get in touch with our real selves and opens the path for us to hear the still, small voice of God. Silence is indeed golden'*. The Mass is where our silent prayer and reflection leads us but also where it is experienced and nurtured. The Second Vatican Council taught that silence *'is one of the languages of the liturgy: words, and music, gestures and silence, movement, liturgical colours'*. Silence, then, is not a separate part of the celebration but integral to it.

It is, then, acceptable to lighten our penances on Sundays if we take them seriously the rest of the week. Sundays allow a respite but not a license to *'binge'*; indeed, if you've given up something to help break a habit, *'taking a break'* may be detrimental. Above all Lent allows us to follow Jesus to Calvary and acquire strength in our struggle over sin and evil.

Liturgy & Prayer

Children's Liturgy of the Word 9am Mass at St Martha's: is held during the 9am Mass on 5th Mar, 19th Mar and 2nd Apr. As you arrive at Mass, collect your child's name stick, and they should bring it with them to the hall. This liturgy is aimed at children in school years R, 1 & 2, who have pre-registered.

Short Lent Talks: Following 10am Mass on Sat. 4th March & Sat. 25th March, Fr Simon offers two short talks: 1) *'The Transfiguration: we let our light be seen'* & 2) *'we have the light of the world to see by'*.

10am Good Friday (St Martha's), Stations of the Cross (led by the CWL): The stations are provided by the Prison Charity 'PACT' with whom the CWL have a 3-year initiative, providing prisoners with a pack on release as well as making a 'Cross in my Pocket' for all Catholic/Orthodox prisoners.
