## Heating Update

### Weekend of 11<sup>th</sup> / 12<sup>th</sup> February 2023

We are still waiting for parts, and the ambient temperature in the Church remains low. **St Mary Magdalene Church** will only open when the temperature in the Church is at least 12°C. This means we remain in **contingency mode**. Decisions for 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> February will be made on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> Feb. Please check online and the newsletter.

## St Martha's Car Park

The car park at St Martha's has been increasingly abused by commercial vehicles, nearby residents, shoppers, and others having no business with the Church and Hall. We have been slowly increasing the signage and gently challenging car drivers but to little avail. And so, gates have now been installed in the car park which from **22<sup>nd</sup> February 2023** will be closed and locked after services and other events. ***Parking outside of these times increases the risk of the vehicle being locked in.*** The advice from the diocese is that our parish sites should be secure, especially where they are largely unsupervised. We will all have to adapt our use of the car park, but in time, we shall see the benefits of a clearer car park.

## They are happy who follow God's law!

### Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> February – An Own Goal?

Tuesday is the Feast of St Cyril and St Methodius, the Apostles to the Slavs, whose princes had requested missionaries. To bring the gospel to the people they translated it into the native language, upsetting the Germans who were concerned about the growing influence of the Slavic culture. While it is true that the traditional languages of the Mass are Latin, Greek and Hebrew, the Pope saw the political advantages of their mission and gave his blessing for the vernacular to be used. Although this is, of course, interesting I wonder if celebrating them on 14<sup>th</sup> February is an 'own goal' by the Church. In old money, Tuesday is **St Valentine's Day**, the day for love. Today, the Church should be preaching 'agape' as the fullest expression of love, *'that greater love hath no man, that he lay down his life for his friend'*. It is the love of the Eucharist, where Jesus declares, *'this is my body which is given up for you'*. For a Catholic, this is the same love found in the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony, where the man and the woman bring their love before the Altar of God and take one another *'for better, for worse, for richer, for poorer, in sickness and in health, to love and to cherish, till death do us part'*.

God bless all of us, especially those in love! Fr Simon.
