This weekend the Vigil Mass is at St Martha's and the 11am Mass at St Mary Magdalene will not be celebrated.

St Martha's Car Park

Therefore, please do not **'double park' down the middle of the car park, and respect any area coned off**. We must allow access for emergency vehicles & ensure safe passage of parishioners who are on foot moving around the site. A reminder that the gates will be closed and locked after services. Parking outside of these times risks the vehicle being locked in.

Our Baptismal Promises

The Transfiguration is a *'sacrament of our regeneration'*, which is twofold. Firstly, we experienced a regeneration when we were baptized, when we died with Christ and rose with him to new life, becoming a new creation, made in the image and likeness of God, especially in our souls. Our second regeneration is yet to come, our resurrection, when we get our bodies back, after the pattern of Christ's own glorious body, taking our place in the new heavens and new earth. In 5 weeks, we renew our baptismal promises, and during Lent and Eastertide, we profess our faith using the **'Apostles Creed'**, which is the foundation of the baptismal promises. There are three key elements to our baptismal promises: *A renunciation of sin, a profession of faith, and the living out of our baptismal dignity*. In the post-baptismal anointing, we are granted a share in the three-fold office of Christ, *'who is priest, prophet, and king'*. As priests, we take part in the sacred liturgy, offering our lives as a thanksgiving sacrifice of praise. As prophets, we have God's Word on our lips, announcing the gospel of the Lord and telling people about our joy in knowing God has called us *'out of darkness into his wonderful light'*. As Kings, we lead people into the Kingdom, especially by the way we live our lives, which are marked out by truth and virtue.

Liturgy & Prayer

Children's Liturgy of the Word 9am Mass at St Martha's: is held during the 9am Mass on 5th Mar, 19th Mar and 2nd Apr. As you arrive at Mass, collect your child's name stick, and they should bring it with them to the hall. This liturgy is aimed at children in school years R, 1 & 2, who have pre-registered.

Short Lent Talk: The 2nd talk is after 10am Mass on 25th March: 'we have the light of the world to see by'.

10am Good Friday (St Martha's), Stations of the Cross (led by the CWL): The stations are provided by the Prison Charity 'PACT' with whom the CWL have a 3-year initiative, providing prisoners with a pack on release as well as making a 'Cross in my Pocket' for all Catholic/Orthodox prisoners.
