The Sacred Paschal Triduum

On this Sunday the Church prays, '*with prompt devotion and eager faith the Christian people may hasten towards the solemn celebrations to come*'. And there is no greater celebration than our participation in the Sacred Paschal Triduum: ***the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, the Commemoration of the Lord's Passion, and the Easter Vigil in the Holy Night.*** These events are the pinnacle of the liturgical year, the Church's equivalent of '*the cup final*' or the '*last night of the proms*'. Hopefully, we will want to make these liturgies a priority in our diaries and help those who find attending evening events difficult, to come and take part.

Triduum in St Mary Magdalene Church

8pm Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday (6th April) followed by watching until Compline at 10.45pm.

3pm The Solemn Commemoration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday (7th April).

8.15pm Easter Vigil in the Holy Night and 1st Mass of Easter (8th April), starts after dark with the blessing of the new fire.
