"The Body of Christ"

The correct response is 'Amen', although I do hear '*Thank you*' from time to time, which is certainly polite but does make me wonder what is being expressed. Remember, to receive Holy Communion licitly in the Catholic Church you need to be in '*Full Communion with the Church*' and to receive Holy Communion fruitfully, at the time of reception, you should be in a state of grace, having fasted for an hour beforehand, and most importantly having made an integral confession of any mortal or serious sins that you are conscious of, so that the divine grace of Holy Communion is digestible by our souls.

Our 'Amen' (meaning "so be it") is an affirmation that we recognize Christ truly present in the Eucharist, and that we receive him '**body, blood, soul, and divinity**' in Holy Communion. On approaching this most august sacrament, we make an act of reverence, a genuflection, or a profound bow before receiving on the tongue, or in the hand by making a throne for Our Lord to sit on, consuming the Host immediately, and not walking off with him, and thus causing anxiety to the priest who remains responsible for the Blessed Sacrament.

Our 'Amen' is our declaration that we are in communion with Francis (*our Pope*) Richard (*our bishop*), and all those who teach and hand on the Catholic and Apostolic Faith. Our 'Amen' is also our assent to everything that the Catholic Church teaches concerning faith and morals. Granted, we may personally still be working through some of this, prayerfully figuring out how to incorporate it into our life, but at the very least we must not be causing scandal by teaching others to ignore the '*words of eternal life*' found in the Gospel. Just as Confirmation makes our baptism stronger, Holy Communion perfects it, nourishing the divine life first given in Baptism, providing our '*viaticum*', our 'food for the journey' back to heaven. God bless your pilgrimage home. Fr Simon.
