#### The Bible – The Word of God

St Paul begins his letter to the Hebrews: *'In many and various ways God spoke of old to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by a Son'*. Our Lord is the ultimate and definitive Word of God and the General Instructions of the Roman Missal remind us that *'When the Sacred Scriptures are read in Church, God himself speaks to his people, and Christ, present in his own word, proclaims the Gospel'*. It is for this reason that the Church urges all of us to read the Bible. After all, as St. Jerome reminds us: *'Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ'*. The books of the Bible, inspired by God, teach us the truth.

Pope Benedict XVI said: *'We must not read Sacred Scripture as words of the past but as the Word of God that is also addressed to us, and we must try to understand what it is that the Lord wants to tell us'*. He further advises us to remember that the Word of God has been given to us specifically to build communion and join forces in the truth on our journey towards God. So, as well as being personal is it also something that builds community and the Church. The Bible is the Word of God because it is one of the ways in which God speaks to us and reveals himself to us so that we may come to know him, love him, and serve him. The Gospels are not just a record of what Christ said but they allow us to listen to him speaking to us as individuals now. They have an ageless and personal quality. How often do you read from your copy?

- 2) 7pm on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> October **or** 9am on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> October (St Martha's Hall).

These two sessions are integral to the First Holy Communion programme and aim to help parents fulfill their promises made at baptism to bring their children up in the Catholic Faith.
