Fire Evacuation Plan / Fire Drill.

Reminders for next week's fire drill (26/27 August), immediately after Holy Communion. Please:

- do not double park in car parks or block gates, preventing access for emergency vehicles.
- do not sit or stand in exits or aisles.
- walk, do not run.
- co-operate when instructed.
- leave bulky items behind.
- familiarize yourself with the exits.
Note: your nearest exit might be unusable or be behind you.
- look around you; who near you might need assistance?
- At St Martha's the muster point is the grassy area on the corner of Birkdale / Cooden Sea Road.
- At St Mary Magdalene, the muster point is the pavement on 'Magdalene Road', outside the hall.
- The Deacon or MC is responsible for evacuating the Altar Servers.
- The duty organist is responsible for evacuating any children or vulnerable adults in the choir.
- do not re-enter until the 'all clear'.

The aim of the exercise is to learn lessons, so there may be issues, so be patient and look out for one another. Thank you.

According to 'Google Maps', the distance between our two Churches is 2 miles, and for many of us we can either walk or drive to Mass or jump on the 99 Bus which stops outside both St Mary Magdalene and St Martha's. We even have a resident priest, meaning that Mass is celebrated each week and the sacraments are administered regularly. And although the NHS is not without its problems, we have (relatively) easy access to health care. However, in other parts of the world, the distance is considerably greater, and the quality of the roads is low; not just the question of a few potholes, for the roads are rarely tarmacked. Today's Retiring Collection, therefore, is to support the missionary work of "**Survive-Miva**" who provide funding to provide transport for the clergy to celebrate Mass and administer the sacraments in remote areas, and for nurses and midwives to provide essential health care, such as vaccinations, awareness on the prevention of the spread of deadly diseases, pre-and post-natal care, HIV testing and counselling, and help and provide advice about basic nutrition, all of which happens far from the main hospital. Between 2019 and 2022, '**Survive Miva**' provided 22 health outreach vehicles, 85 motorbikes and mopeds, 522 bicycles and 2 small motorboats, at a total cost of £608,000.
