Fire Evacuation Plan / Fire Drill.

THIS SUNDAY! (26/27 August), immediately after Holy Communion.

Please:

- do not double park in car parks or block gates, preventing access for emergency vehicles.
- do not sit or stand in exits or aisles.
- walk, do not run.
- co-operate when instructed.
- leave bulky items behind.
- familiarize yourself with the exits.
Note: your nearest exit might be unusable or be behind you.
- look around you; who near you might need assistance?
- At St Martha's the muster point is the grassy area on the corner of Birkdale / Cooden Sea Road.
- At St Mary Magdalene, the muster point is the pavement on 'Magdalene Road', outside the hall.
- The Deacon or MC is responsible for evacuating the Altar Servers.
- The duty organist is responsible for evacuating any children or vulnerable adults in the choir.
- do not re-enter until the 'all clear'.

The aim of the exercise is to learn lessons, so there may be issues, so be patient and look out for one another. Thank you.

Monday 28th August is the 5th Anniversary of my appointment as Parish Priest. There have been many challenges and the brief the Diocese gave me was to urgently balance the operational budget, which was accomplished through the closures of the Parish Nursery and Sidley, and by staff redundancies, all while being hampered by COVID. As you would imagine, this was not the dream I had for my first appointment as parish priest, and I am conscious that some found these decisions hard, in themselves, or the way in which they were enacted. Among the promises I made at my Induction, there was one you did not see because it was made in the sacristy; it was the promise to manage the temporal goods of the parish. As Parish Priest, I hold the legal responsibility to ensure that the '*mission*' is conducted in line with Diocesan Health & Safety policies. As parents might appreciate, part of being a '*father*' includes unpopular decisions because they have the long term good of the parish in mind. The Parish Priest is appointed by the bishop to help him sanctify, govern, and teach the People of God in this part of the Diocese. Borrowing from Isaish, it is akin to his words to the House of David, '***I invest him with your robe, gird him with your authority; and he shall be a Father***' to the people. And so, I renew my promise to only teach that which is in accord Sacred Scripture and the Tradition of the Catholic Church. As to the parish's temporal resources, I am in active discussions with the Diocese to consider how, in line with the Diocesan Pastoral Plan, the management of our current estate best serves the mission of the gospel in Bexhill. This is a complex issue, and with Diocesan guidance, I and the Finance Committee will keep you apprised as we know more. What I can tell you, it will require a renewed commitment to mission and service from all parishioners. God bless. Fr Simon.
