The role of sacristan is a very important ministry. The sacristan not only supports the priest, but their work enables the whole community to fully participate in the liturgical celebrations. Their role ensures that there is no frantic rush to organise things before Mass and prevents a 'break' in proceedings because something essential has been left in the cupboard in the sacristy.

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal simply states that the sacristan "... diligently arranges the liturgical books, the vestments and other things that are necessary for the celebration of Mass" (no. 105). This also means that work needs to be done to ensure that what is required for Mass is clean, well-maintained, and in good supply.

There may be a number of volunteers to assist as sacristans. Some may prepare the church for Mass each Sunday, while some others take the responsibility for tasks such as washing linen, cleaning the sacred vessels, or checking the supply of requisites such as bread and wine. Things like the candlesticks, thurible and processional cross need to be cleaned, polished, and maintained to ensure they are at their best and fit for purpose for the Celebration of Mass.

Those who minister in the sacristy perform a valuable and essential role for the good of our parish community.

Many hands make light work, and we urgently need more volunteers at both churches to help those that are currently carrying out this ministry.
