November: The Month of the Holy Souls

This Month, we pray for the Holy Souls in Purgatory, especially those in our funeral books of remembrance: '*Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them, may they rest in peace. Amen.*' We invite you to place a photograph of a loved one you are grieving for on the Pieta Side Altar (St Mary Magdalene) or Our Lady's Side Altar (St Martha's) up until 17th November so we can pray for them.

The photographs from St Mary Magdalene will be transferred to St Martha's where we will celebrate our Annual Bereavement Mass at **10am on Saturday 18th November**. On **12th November, at 11am** (as the time suggests), we shall have our annual Requiem Mass for the those fallen in War, and at other Masses there will be an opportunity to mark Remembrance Sunday. After the 11am Mass, we will have the blessing of the Ashes plots in the Memorial Garden at St Mary Magdalene, and then at 2.30pm the blessing of graves at Bexhill Cemetery in Turkey Road. I will be walking through the graveyard, so please invite me over to bless a family grave.

On **Tuesday 14th November, at 12noon** there will be the Annual Deceased Mass for the Deanery Clergy & Religious at St Mary Star of the Sea, Hastings. This Mass replaces the 11am Mass, and if you normally come to weekday Masses, please do try and come to Hastings to pray for the repose of the souls of those who have served us so well over the years.

This month when you come to Mass, try and offer your intention for the Holy Souls, a fulfilment of the Spiritual Work of Mercy to pray for the dead. '*May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.*' Fr Simon.
