*From page 3 of the abridged version:*

The principal role of the priest is the preaching of the Word, the celebration of the sacraments and the pastoral care of the people placed in his charge. We must enable the priests of the Diocese to be free to carry out these prime responsibilities of their vocation. The many employees and volunteers in our parish communities play an important part in the mission, and the future sees the development of existing & new roles.

*Fr Simon ponders, 'perhaps, we need to move urgently to an assumption that the priest will be ministering further afield, and that he will not be available to open / close the Church and will arrive expecting everything ready for Mass and the sacraments (and done in accord with the custom of the Universal Church)'.*

### Repairs Update – Spring 2024

Hopefully you have read last year's accounts which outlined the way forward for our buildings, especially at St Mary Magdalene. If not, you will find the 2022 Accounts here:

Once the Diocese has approved the 2023 Accounts, we will bring these to you. In December, (*in line with the bishop's & Trustees wishes and with the approval of the Parish & Diocesan Finance Committees*), I appointed Harding Bond as the managing-surveyor for the repairs at St Mary Magdalene Church. They have instructed a Quantity Surveyor to provide a clear picture of costs, and that the repairs are in line with our expectations and funding coming from the sale of Sidley, which we hope completes this year now that the intended buyer has finally been able to submit their planning permission for development. Once we have a 'schedule of works', we will submit it to Historic Churches (South) to ensure we are managing the repairs in line with our listed building obligations. Then we go to out to tender. Despite our best efforts, therefore, we may not see any physical works before Sept. 2024 or even spring 2025 depending on the progress of the above and the autumn weather. The Presbytery & Hall at St Mary Magdalene are now on the market, and we have had three viewings but no offers yet. Money raised will hopefully fund new (*yet undefined*) pastoral space at St Mary Magdalene. Some repairs are also needed at St Martha's, funded from our **operational budget** which is not the sole responsibility of the people of St Martha's, but of the whole parish. This is your annual encouragement to review your (gift-aided) offertory giving. Fundraising for the parish is also needed! Fr Simon.
