It is best to read the whole plan, but some pertinent paragraphs will be shared in the newsletter.

5.8: The groupings of parishes that form deaneries, will come parishes. The numbers of priests will continue to decline over an extended number of years. In structural terms, this gives us two alternatives: either to reduce the number of parishes gradually (which extends a period of pain and uncertainty and is problematic as vacancies do not always occur in places that would be suitable for amalgamation) or take the bold step of reducing the number of parishes in one go to a level that is sustainable long-term. Once the Diocese is restructured, each parish can be run with the number of available priests. This gives the flexibility to respond to challenges in a way that is resilient, sustainable, and adaptable.

Marriage Week: 7th – 14th February

The Church celebrates Holy Matrimony, that ‘*partnership of the whole of life and which is ordered by its nature to the good of the spouses and the procreation and education of offspring, which has been raised by Christ the Lord to the dignity of a sacrament between the baptized*’ (Canon Law, p.1055.1). **For a Catholic**, baptism binds the individual to the Church’s law and ‘form’ (*the who, what, where and how*) of marriage. It is essential for a Catholic planning to get married to see the parish priest of where they live (*not where they worship*) to ensure that any permissions or dispensations (where needed) can be arranged, as these may have future implications for the licit and fruitful reception of Holy Communion. As consent to enter marriage is given ‘*until death do us part*’, marriage preparation is needed; as such, 12 months’ notice is required in Arundel & Brighton (*this assumes everything is straightforward and does not require a referral to the Diocesan Marriage Tribunal due to previous marriages of any sort*). **Marriage preparation is an area highly suited to the lay apostolate** as married couples bring their experience of Holy Matrimony to the preparation process (speak to Deacon Simon if you feel called to being part of the lay-led Diocesan Marriage Preparation team). This week, we pray for married couples and engaged couples but also those whose marriages are in difficulty. We pray also **for Catholics** civilly married outside the Church, either in a registry office (*considered sacramentally invalid by the Church*) or to Christian of another denomination where the required permissions or dispensation were not sought. Now, perhaps, is the time to ask their parish priest to ‘**convalidate**’ such marriages, to receive the nuptial blessing and return to a licit and fruitful reception of Holy Communion. Your parish priest can also advise a Catholic previously married, now civilly divorced, who wishes to explore the annulment process. With every blessing, Fr Simon.
