It is best to read the whole plan but here are some extracts:

5:9: With such a structure in place, the teams of priests living across this wider community will then be able to cooperate more closely, serving the sacramental needs of the communities concerned in a flexible way and freed to bring their gifts to the service of the Church in Mission.

5.12: Church communities will need to identify suitable lay people to act as an advertised point of contact for those requiring pastoral care and to organise visits and other pastoral care, in collaboration with the priests and deacons of the parish.

Ash Wednesday – 14th February 2024

This Wednesday is 'Ash Wednesday' and the start of the fast of the Sacred Lenten Season. Although it is 'Valentine's Day', it remains a day of **fasting** (for those aged 18-59) and **abstinence** (for those aged 14+). Fasting means to eat less, to have one main meal and two snacks, whereas Abstinence means we eat no meat today. Clearly, anyone with underlying health conditions should act cautiously and not deprive themselves of any necessary nutrition for their condition, as all our penances are not meant to be torture but little acts of love to the Lord, in response to the ultimate act of love of his sacrifice on the cross by which he gives his life so that we might have life and have it in abundance. Perhaps, then, the best way for couples to express their love for each other is to come to the 'Agape Love Feast' that is the celebration of the Most Holy Eucharist. Holy Masses will be celebrated in St Mary Magdalene at 11am and 7pm on Wednesday.

There are, of course, further opportunities for abstinence on all Fridays (except when a solemnity falls on a Friday), and there will be another opportunity to Fast on CAFOD's 'Family Fast Day' (23rd Feb) which is also a good way of fulfilling the Almsgiving requirement of Lent. This season is also marked by Prayer, and I draw your attention to the item about 'Stations of the Cross' on page 2 and 'Invited' on Page 3 of this newsletter. Every blessing for the Season. Fr Simon.
