Most Holy Trinity Sunday

Temporary Changes to Mass times in the month of June.

As in previous years, there is no 10am Sat. Mass on 8th & 15th June due to the First Holy Communions. Masses on 10th & 13th June are cancelled due to the 'Clergy In-Service' which disrupts Fr Simon's diary. **Additionally**, there is no 10am Mass on Friday 20th June due to the 'Thameslink Pilgrimage' to St Albans. And on **Saturday 22nd June, the Anticipated (or Vigil) Mass of the Sunday is at 7pm** (not 6pm) because of the Ordinations to the Priesthood at Arundel Cathedral at 2.30pm, meaning Fr Simon cannot be back for 6pm.

In our homilies, Deacon Simon and I have been reminding the parish of the call to service. In response, many people have shown a willingness to be involved but, in many areas, – *especially those running with interim arrangements* - we have no one to whom we can sign post them. The first step, then, is to appoint **co-ordinators** who can take responsibility for an area of ministry, maintenance, and mission so that volunteers know who to speak to about getting involved. The co-ordinator takes responsibility, liaises with the parish office, draws up rotas, completes any risk assessments / safeguarding requirements, find appropriate resources, and is a point of contact for enquiries & queries. To start, these are the areas of priority that currently have no **co-ordinator**:

- Coordinator for the Liturgy of the Word for Children,
- Lead Catechist for Baptism Preparation,
- Lead Catechist for First Holy Communion,
- Lead Catechist for RCIA,
- Chair of the Parish Finance Committee,
- Coordinator of Parish Social Life and Fundraising,
- Caretaker / Groundskeeper for St Martha's,
- Caretaker / Groundskeeper for St Mary Magdalene,
- Youth Officer (ages 8-12), Youth Officer (ages 13-17)

Many roles need Parish **DBS** clearance and **CCSA Safeguarding Training**. Some roles are self-explanatory, some are a blank canvas, others need input from other groups or committees, especially the Parish Pastoral Core Group and 'Moderated Parish'. Most roles need my approval as I am the Chief Catechist for the parish and have legal responsibility for Health & Safety. Please pray and discern if the Holy Spirit is calling you to coordinate one of these voluntary roles, then let me know. Many thanks. Fr Simon.
