New Translation of the Lectionary this Advent.

In England & Wales (and Scotland), a new Lectionary will be used from Advent. The current Lectionary (*using the Jerusalem Bible Translation*) has been in use since 1981 and while it has served us well it is time for a refresh; and our own copies are falling apart! The new lectionary uses the '*English Standard Version*' (ESV) for 1st & 2nd Reading and the Gospel, and the '*Abbey Translation*' for the Psalms. The ESV has been judged as well-suited for '*Proclamation*', as the Sunday readings are proclaimed not read. The new Church Lectionaries will be printed in '*sense lines*' to help the Minister of the Word better convey the meaning of Jesus' Word or the prophet's or apostle's message. Our parish readers are encouraged, as now, to prepare themselves to read each week, having looked at the Sunday readings in advance. This helps us receive God's Word, allowing it to bear fruit in the hearer. For each Church, I have placed a '*pre-order*' for new Lectionaries and a Book of the Gospels (*and study editions for the parish office*). We expect to receive them around October for **mandatory, exclusive and immediate use** from the beginning of Advent for all Sunday and Weekday Masses, including funerals and weddings. If we receive them earlier, the bishop says we may start using them. There is a three-year grace period for the musicians who sing the psalm (as is proper, for they are songs) to allow time for good settings to be composed and learned – although composers are already working on this. The cost to the parish, even with a pre-order 15% discount is £2,200 but the books come with dedication sheets, so if anyone would like to sponsor a lectionary (volume 1-4 & book of the Gospels) and help cover the cost, please contact the office.
