Saint Peter and Saint Paul, Apostles.

Proper Vigil Mass:

Their word goes forth through all the earth

Mass of the Day:

From all my terrors the Lord set me free **or**

The angel of the Lord rescues those who revere him

Rome, not Jerusalem, is our focus.

At the end of our seminary formation, my year had a wonderful pilgrimage to the Holy Land, walking in the footsteps of Jesus Christ. This is something that probably cannot happen again for some time. The Acts of the Apostles records the rapid progress of the Apostles in fulfilling the Lord's command: *'go out to the whole world; proclaim the Good News to all creation'*. For this to happen, the Gospel must reach Rome, the secular centre of power and governance. In AD64, both Peter and Paul lay down their lives for the sake of the Gospel, the Basilica of St Peter and the Basilica of St Paul built over their place of martyrdom / tombs. Eucharistic Prayer 1, the *'Roman Canon'*, lists the next bishops of Rome: *'Linus, Cletus, Clement and Sixtus...'* and Pope Francis would be number 266 if all the popes were read out in the Mass, maintaining this Petrine Succession and Primacy over the College of Apostles which is promised to Peter: **presented** to us in the Gospel of the Mass of the Day and **restored** to him in the Gospel of the Vigil Mass. Those who receive Holy Communion in this Church do so *(providing they are properly prepared and disposed)* because they have been baptised into the Church of God and are in communion with the Church Catholic: *'with Francis our Pope and Richard our own bishop and apostle, and all those who teach and hand on the Catholic and Apostolic Faith'*. As the Collect for the Mass of the Day says, may the *'Church, in all things, follow the teaching of those [the Apostles] through whom she received [from Christ] the beginnings of right religion'*. Happy Feast Day. Fr Simon.
