Taste and see that the Lord is good!

Grant we may revere the sacred mysteries of His Body and Blood and experience our Redemption.

Throughout the summer, we have heard *'John 6'* beautifully explain the Eucharist as being Christ's Body and Blood, and to have life, we must eat his flesh and drink his blood. For many, *'this was intolerable language... and many of his disciples left him and stopped going with him'*. Today, many people have stopped coming to Mass, perhaps, because they do not know what the Eucharist is, not seeing it as the *'source and summit'* of our life. At Mass, the one sacrifice of Christ (*that takes away the sins of the world*) is re-presented to us. By being joined to Christ's death and resurrection, we give thanks for our redemption (*our restoration to life*), and in the Communion we share, the community is united to the life of the Trinity now and for eternity: *'we proclaim the death of Christ and profess his resurrection, until He comes again.'* Christ is really and substantially present to us: in the community gathered, in the priest, in His Word, and most especially in the species of his body and blood. *'O God, who in this wonderful Sacrament have left us a memorial of your Passion, grant us, we pray, so to revere the sacred mysteries of your body and blood that we may always experience in ourselves the fruits of your redemption, through Christ our Lord'*. In the Mass, the past and future are bound together in the present. As God's people, we gather in fellowship as a parish community, but we are also in the upper room, at the foot of the cross and in the garden of the Resurrection. Above all, we are in heaven and given a foretaste of the heavenly banquet to come, a glimpse of our true nature, destiny and dignity. As the psalmist has sung throughout August: *'taste and see that the Lord is good'* and as St Peter recognises, *'Lord, you have the message of eternal life'*. Fr Simon.
