### **Fr Simon writes... 'Our Lady of Fatima'**

This Sunday is also the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima, the place where Our Lady appeared to the Shepherd Children between 13<sup>th</sup> May & 13<sup>th</sup> October 1917, warning us of the harm we inflict on ourselves by our sins. Wars, famines, plagues and persecution all find their root in our disordered desires and lead many souls astray: ***O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, leads all souls to heaven, especially those in most need of thy mercy.*** In November, we remember the faithful departed and it is a 'spiritual work of Mercy' to pray for the Holy Souls, never assuming that our loved ones went straight to heaven, and that they may be in need of our prayers as they completed their purification in purgatory. Our 2<sup>nd</sup> RCIA topic on 14<sup>th</sup> November (6.30pm Mass followed by talk) will be on the Four Last things: *Death, Judgment Heaven and Hell*. All are welcome at Mass, and I am happy if parishioners not on the course stay for the talk as well, as we could all do with extra formation. On 7<sup>th</sup> Oct, Pope Francis asked for prayers for peace, especially in Russia / Ukraine & the Middle East. As Our Lady said at Fatima: ***Continue to say the Rosary to bring about the end of the [1<sup>st</sup> World] war.*** May the peace of Christ reign in our hearts, now and in the world to come.

Please contact our MP and urge him to vote 'no' on legalising **'Assisted Suicide'**. On Wed. 16 October, the bill has its 1<sup>st</sup> reading in the House of Commons, and it is likely that MPs will get to vote on assisted suicide before Christmas. Life is a gift to be cherished from conception until natural death. The bill may well be supported by 'well-known' figures in society but is at odds with Church's teaching which consistently teaches about the dignity of life.
