To you, O Lord, I lift up my soul.

I went over to Eastbourne by train the other day. Standing on the platform, I could see the announcement system telling me that my train had left Warrior Square, and I also followed the time-honoured tradition of staring along the track waiting until I could see the train in the distance. It amused me to think how often over the years I have done just that!

In a way, Advent is a funny name for the season we are just entering. "Adventus" in Latin means arrival, and yet we are actually waiting for Christ's arrival, preparing to welcome him at Christmas. It does, however, focus us on why we are waiting. Historically, it was a time of abstinence, just like Lent, but it doesn't have quite the same sense of "giving up things". In fact, it is a season with its own distinct character.

We are firstly recalling the long wait for the Messiah to come the first time. From the earliest days of Jewish faith, but particularly as time wore on, there was a great sense that someone needed to come from God. We of course know that that "Son of Man", as Daniel foresaw, is the Son of God. In many ways, we are bringing to life again that great desire to receive Jesus in our world and our hearts.

Also, we are remembering his promise to return. St Paul clearly thought that this would happen soon. We know of course that it hasn't, but this great season allows us to think and pray that Christ will return in glory.

Overall, it is a great time to renew our desire to receive Jesus in our lives. Let's make, if you will, that crib in the manger in our hearts, ready to know with ever greater joy that he is truly with us, as he said, until the end of the age.

Building Update: Having completed the Tendering Process, the Parish Finance Committee, with Diocesan approval have appointed Minerva Building Restoration Limited to carry out repairs to the South and West walls, elevations and windows. This work begins in the Spring of 2025, lasting for approx. 30 weeks, at a cost of £300K. In 2026, we will address the other aspects of the Church at an additional cost.
