Remembrance & 32nd Sunday in O.T. B.

My soul, give praise to the Lord.

We will remember them.

The month of November is not about us, and this is especially true of Remembrance Sunday. For once, we have not come here to make ourselves feel better but to pray for the faithful departed, especially today, for those fallen in war: ***'They shall grow not old, as we that are left grow old: age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn. At the going down of the sun and in the morning, we will remember them'***. The 11am Mass at St Mary Magdalene will be a special Requiem Mass for the War Dead, and at the other two Masses there will be the customary opportunities for silence, to pause and remember those who gave their lives for our country's freedom. If the weather permits, the 11am Mass begins outside at the Parish's *'Peace Memorial'* for the best way to remember and honour their sacrifice, is a continued commitment to peace and reconciliation.

On Saturday 23rd November, we will turn the attention to ourselves as we celebrate our Annual Bereavement Mass, and I draw your attention to the information about Bereavement on page 2 of this newsletter. This will be Fr Stephen's first Mass with us. God bless you. Fr Simon.

Building Update: Having completed the Tendering Process, the Parish Finance Committee, with Diocesan approval have appointed Minerva Building Restoration Limited to carry out repairs to the South and West walls, elevations and windows. This work begins in the Spring of 2025, lasting for approx. 30 weeks, at a cost of £300K. In 2026, we will address the other aspects of the Church at an additional cost.

Little Common public car park £1.30 for 4hrs; please do not enter the public car park via the exit which is marked with "no-entry signs".
