Third 'Gaudete' Sunday of Advent, C.

**Shout aloud and sing praise,
for great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel.**

As I write this, I am looking at this Thursday's Gospel, where Jesus speaks of how the Kingdom of Heaven is under threat even as He speaks. It reminds me of the first thing ever said to me when I started seminary training for the priesthood: that there has never been a "golden age" in the Church. This is of course quite true: every age of the life of the Church has had good things about it, but also dangers and downsides.

We might, however, be understandably nervous that this age in the life of our parish has had great challenges. We have seen and are seeing differences in the way we work: after all, I am writing this at my desk in the Presbytery, a building which is currently for sale!

Of course, this is against the backdrop of the parishes of our Deanery preparing to come together into a wider parish community of communities. There may be fears that this will lead to the disappearance of our vibrant community spirit. However, this could not be further from the intention of Bishop Richard in furthering this plan.

He is working to ensure that, against challenging financial times, and a background of increasingly fewer priests, all our communities will be preserved as both individual places where the Gospel may be proclaimed and lived and part of a wider Christ-filled community, with activities taking place both locally and more widely, as appropriate. Mass, particularly Sunday Mass, will be offered as widely as possible with the numbers of priests available, while there will be many opportunities for all of us to live our common Baptismal calling as priests, prophets, queens and kings by encouraging and leading prayer, liturgies and activities across our communities.

It's normal to be a little nervous when we step out into the unknown. Let's, however, ask God to be with us as we continue to proclaim His Gospel. After all, during the first Advent, few could have imagined that that would lead to two millennia of God's salvation. Let's have courage, that, wherever and however we proclaim that salvation, God will always be with us on that journey.
