

The Wild Goose series course

The Wild Goose Project is a course to invite Catholic Christians into a more profound life-giving relationship with the Holy Spirit. This is a relationship marked by the love of God which breathes life into our daily existence. The Wild Goose is the name that the Celts gave to the Holy Spirit as he leads people where he wills, if they let him.

Here are the episodes and dates. The sessions will take place in St Mary Magdalene presbytery until further notice. They will take place on the last Thursday of each month unless the dates need to be changed because of the school holidays. Each session will start at 7.15pm for a 7.30pm prompt start with prayer, the short Wild Goose film and a study document based on the film to encourage discussion and reflection.
