SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME, C

Blessed the man who has placed his trust in the Lord.

Some people may remember the Cypriot political leader in the 1950s, who was also a senior clergyman- Archbishop Makarios. This would not have been his name at birth- in the Orthodox Church it is common for bishops to have a name which means something to do with God. In his case, he took the name Makarios as the Greek word μακάριος means "blessed".

You may notice this weekend that one change in the new translation of the readings is that today's Gospel, Luke's version of the Beatitudes, reads "Blessed are...". The previous version said, "Happy are...". Certainly, a more commonly used word, but it's good that we are led to think a little about this idea.

Not that the Greek word was always something with a special meaning. The very sarcastic Greek playwright Aristophanes used it to take the mickey out of people or places who were thought lucky with the Greek gods. It could just mean fortunate: it was used by the historian Herodotus to describe an oasis in the desert. However, these might lead us to think about how Jesus might be using it in the Gospels.

For starters, it does tend to have a meaning to do with being favoured by God. This draws us to the idea that those whom Jesus describes as "blessed" are especially loved and cared for by God.

It of course is used more surprisingly than that here. The first "blessed" group are the ptochoi in the Greek. This means more than just the poor- it means "blessed are the beggars". God loves especially those whom the world would never consider as fortunate.

So, what we can see here is that everyone, no matter how humble or suffering, will receive special blessings from Jesus. Let's rejoice that God loves us so much that, whatever happens, we remain within his love and blessings.
