PENTECOST SUNDAY, C

**Send forth your spirit, O Lord,
and renew the face of the earth.**

This weekend, we celebrate the great feast of Pentecost. The name is perhaps a little misleading- the name comes from the Greek pentekonta, which simply means “fifty”- (roughly) the number of days since Easter. What this does show us is that this feast is clearly part of God’s plan- the Resurrection was always meant to lead to Jesus’ ascension to Heaven, and to this feast. This fits neatly with Jesus’ promise that he and the Father would send us another “paraclete”- literally a person “called down together” (by Jesus and the Father), but often translated “comforter” or “advocate”.

This leads us to see something important. The idea of the Spirit of God is not new at the first Pentecost- the “ruach”, or Spirit, of God floats over the waters in the creation story in the Book of Genesis. However, what is new is exactly who the Holy Spirit is. He is, firstly, one of the three Persons of the Trinity- he is “co-equal” with the Father and with Jesus. He has the same importance as they do in the Trinity. This means that our faith in Him can be and must be as sure and absolute as in Them.

However, there is a wonderful, apparently contradictory, part of the nature of the Holy Spirit. As seen in Acts, the Holy Spirit came with the force of a great wind. The power of the Spirit is tangible, and a great comfort as our defender. However, the Spirit is also gentle, working within us to change our lives, comfort us in distress, and show us God’s will for us. In fact, these are both ways in which the Holy Spirit works. So let’s today rejoice that God has given us this great defender, comforter and guide. *veni, Sancte Spiritus-* come, O Holy Spirit!
