SAINTS PETER & PAUL SUNDAY, C

From all my terrors the Lord set me free.

It is, as I have mentioned almost every Sunday of late, a coincidence that every Sunday for about a month has been a great feast of the Church. By coincidence, this year, as holy days which occur near a Sunday are moved to that Sunday, we have another great feast: St Peter and St Paul. I mentioned on Tuesday that there are but a few saints who get more than one feast day. These two are in that category. Why?

Well, to begin with, they are saints instrumental in the very beginning of the Christian faith. However, there is more than that, I think. What can they both tell us?

St Peter is the great example of someone who is on a path of learning. From the lakeside in Galilee, through to his time learning what it means to be a disciple, he learns so much. He has to understand that leadership means service; that forgiveness is unlimited. He must then learn that he ought not to deny Christ, but that Jesus will always forgive him. The humble fisherman from the unfashionable end of the Holy Land becomes the first Pope, and is constantly forgiven when he gets things wrong.

St Paul is the great example of someone, meanwhile, whose faith is turned round. We must never forget that the Saul who approves of Stephen's killing believes in God, and thinks he is doing exactly the right thing. It will take a literal journey- to Damascus- for him to learn that he is called to preach Christ to the Gentiles- ie the whole world.

God uses people who are in the right place to do his work. The humble nature of Peter is vital to show the world that God loves everyone. Paul is a Roman citizen- his embrace of Christ cannot be ignored by the powers that be. What they show is that all of us are called, whoever and wherever we are, to do his work in the world.
