15th OT C:

Seek God, you who are poor,
and your hearts will revive.

Feast of St Mary Magdalene (16th OT C):

O Lord, who may abide in your tent?

Feast of St Martha's (17th OT C):

On the day I called, you answered me, O Lord.

One of the great joys of our faith, I think, is that we have a host of Saints praying for us to Jesus in heaven. If we take the image offered in Revelation, we could think of them gathered round Jesus on his heavenly throne. We can have personal connections with them for many reasons. We can ask our namesake for prayers. We can pray to patron saints for particular causes. We can have devotions to local saints- I think Sussex has some great ones, such as St Philip Howard or St Richard of Chichester.

Our two Churches are dedicated to two wonderful saints. Over the next few weeks, we shall honour both of them. St Martha teaches us so much. Her life of service shows that God loves us when we labour for others. Her very human reproach to Christ after the death of Lazarus gives Jesus the opportunity to teach about the resurrection and to show how he wants to treat us kindly.

St Mary Magdalene is of course on hand as a key disciple during the events of Holy Week. Her witness has inspired so many to marvel at Jesus' love and at his resurrection. A figure of devotion to Jesus, she has shown us how to love him.

Let's take these opportunities to ask for the intercession of these two wonderful saints. May they inspire us in our work, faith and love. St Mary Magdalene and St Martha, pray for us!
