NINETEENTH SUNDAY OT, C

**Blessed the people the Lord
has chosen as his heritage.**

It's high summer, and I don't want to be the one who reminds everyone that in a few weeks the chill winds of autumn will be blowing along the promenade, but the nights are beginning, ever so slightly, to draw in. No longer is dusk postponed until 9pm, and the mornings too are not dawning at 3am. The cycle of the year is turning.

Darkness has always had an impact on humanity. We are hard-wired to enjoy the light, and fear the darkness (even those of us who prefer the cool, dewy mists of an autumn morning!). When I had the privilege of spending a few weeks with the Mill Hill Missionaries in Kenya, one of the first pieces of advice I was given was never to travel in the hours of darkness. We justly fear for our safety more, even when electric light has changed the nature of the night.

Jesus, knowing, as fully human, our inmost thoughts and fears, knows that we prefer the light. John uses this image to show Christ as the light himself. In today's Gospel, however, it is used differently: we are reminded to keep our light burning. This is of course a reference more fully understood in a world where a tiny light was needed to illumine the utter darkness of the night. It however gives us the realisation that we can do so much by letting our light shine to penetrate the darkness of a world which so often ignores Christ, the true source of light. This gives greater meaning to our parish mission: we must figuratively show the world all we can do, but also literally be beacons in the world, points of hope. Let's bring the light of Christ into our world, as surely as the dawning sun brings light and hope to humankind.
