Lord, make haste to help me!

The Gospel this weekend reminds us of the unpalatable truth that our faith, far from uniting us, frequently causes divisions, where some members of our family and friends may accept Jesus, while others scorn them for it. Taken by itself, that might lead us to despair, but let's think about the hope which God has put into our world as well.

Before the Prince Regent made Brighton turn from a fishing community into a fashionable resort, our part of the world was somewhat off the beaten track. When the railway came through Bexhill in the 1840s, it was a small rural community around where the Town Hall now stands. Over the intervening years, the community grew, spreading itself towards the coastline and welcoming visitors. By the 20th century, it was ready for such grand visions of the future as the De La Warr Pavilion- and St Mary Magdalene's, of course. The community spread west and north, with Little Common and Sidley developing from small foundations.

If our town has grown into such a wonderful place, we can think of the hope which engendered such developments. Hope is the great gift which God wants to give us- not despair. As we go forward into new and perforce unknown territory, let's ask God for renewed hope that, no matter what hurdles lie ahead, we may rejoice to see his Spirit guiding us into the future.
