Weekday Mass and Reconciliation (a selection)

St Mary, Star of the Sea, Hastings - High Street, Hastings. Take bus numbers 100/101/321 from Hastings Station and alight on Old London Road at the Market Cross. Mass: 10am except Mondays. Confessions: after Saturday 10am Mass.

Our Lady of Ransom, Eastbourne - Grange Road, Eastbourne. Take the train to Eastbourne and walk up by the library or take the 99 bus and walk up South Street.

Mass: 11am (10am Saturday). Confessions: after Saturday 10am Mass.

Christ the King, Langley A259 at Seaside roundabout beyond Asda. Take the 99 bus and alight at first stop after roundabout. Mass: Tuesday 10am; Friday 12 noon. Confessions: after Friday 12 midday Mass.

St Thomas of Canterbury, St Leonards Magdalene Road. Park on road. Take the train to St Leonards Warrior Square, but beware the steep climb. Take the 100 bus from Hastings Station to the Fire Station. Mass: Thursday and Friday 10am.

Holy Redeemer, Hollington Sedlescombe Road near junction with Harrow Lane. Car park behind church. Take the 100 or 321 bus towards Conquest Hospital and alight at bottom of Harrow Lane. Mass: Monday, Tuesday and Saturday 10am.
