TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY OT C

**The Lord has shown his salvation
to the nations.**

In my mother's generation, there were a whole range of illnesses which stalked the land: whether it be tuberculosis or rheumatic fever (some will remember the isolation hospitals where patients lived often for years with treatment largely involving fresh and cold air), bronchitis, or whooping cough. It was an age where terrible, life-threatening or life-limiting illnesses were so often a great fear. The twin breakthroughs of antibiotics and vaccination have made these things largely of the past, at least in western societies (though we remember only too well the fear and loss caused by Covid).

It is therefore sometimes difficult to relate to the fear caused by leprosy in the ancient world. This caused sufferers to be doubly afflicted: both by the horrible disease and by a perfectly understandable and yet very troubling for the sufferers' desire by most people to shun them.

One group who are afflicted in a particular way and are often shunned by society are those who are in prison. In the past, I have helped as a volunteer with prison ministry, and I noted how much the prisoners received from meeting the love of God in the prison chapel at Mass. On Prisoners' Sunday, let us pray that they may know God's help in their lives.

Of course, we might forget the absolute joy which those afflicted would feel at discovering that God has helped and saved them by healing and love. Even from our fortunate position, let's see where God is helping us, and give thanks to him for his loving care.
