lux in tenebris

The dark nights are upon us. Rain, wind and even a little snow are pummelling us. The weak winter sun rises fleetingly over the horizon, and returns swiftly to leave us in night and cold. The trees hang bare, mere shadows of their summer glory. Coat collars are turned up as we brace ourselves against the chill.

You might be forgiven for thinking that the Church is sharing in this barren winter. Suddenly the colour of mourning is everywhere. We do not sing God's glory, but beg forgiveness and then speed to the Collect in Mass.

In fact, Advent was originally seen as a penitential season, preparing for the Lord's nativity just as we spend time with Jesus in the desert in Lent to prepare for the Resurrection. However, Advent is subtly different. We do reflect on how we need to prepare for Christmas, and it is a very good thing to come to Reconciliation, especially if our lives are too busy for regular Confession at other times.

But there is something else truly wonderful in Advent. God knows that we are mired in midwinter, both literally and in the struggle of our earthly pilgrimage against the blandishments of the world. We are given that glimpse of hope: the light which came into the world two millennia ago, a foretaste of the salvation he brought to us; the light which is truly with us on our altar; the shining glory for which we wait even now to return. The darkness can never overcome that light, and we can and must cleave to that light of salvation. Let us prepare a way for that light this Advent, and always.
